2016 New Jersey Arts Annual: Fine Art

The Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University, in partnership with the New Jersey State Council on the Arts, is proud to present the *2016 New Jersey Arts Annual: Fine Art.* The New Jersey Arts Annual (NJAA) is a unique series of exhibitions highlighting the work of New Jersey artists, one in fine arts and the other in crafts, at major museums across the state. The series is sponsored by the New Jersey State Council on the Arts in partnership with The Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University, the Montclair Art Museum, the Morris Museum, The Newark Museum, and the New Jersey State Museum. The selected works, by a roster of artists at all stages of their careers, highlights a cross-section of contemporary art production by artists living and/or working in New Jersey.

The Noyes Museum, along with jurors Joan Bacharach, Senior Curator, National Park Service, Museum Management Program and Stacy Smith, Manager of Publications and Communications, Zimmerli Art Museum at Rutgers University (past curator, The Noyes Museum of Art), juried the largest pool of applicants in the history of the NJAA exhibition series with 1,183 artworks submitted. There are 51 exhibiting artists, making this also the largest group of participants in the history of the NJAA and compelling evidence of New Jersey's dedication to and passion for the arts.
