10th Annual Paint Hammonton: Plein-Air Competition & Exhibition

The Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University presents the 10th Annual Paint Hammonton: Plein-Air Competition & Exhibition, a competition that attracts artists from across New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Delaware. Artists set up their easels at locations of their choice all around the town of Hammonton to capture the effects of natural light, quickly capturing a scene before it's gone. At the end of the day, the works are judged in the Noyes Museum Gallery at Kramer Hall, and First, Second, Third and Honorable Mention Prizes are awarded. The Plein-Air Exhibition is on view from September 11 to December 2, 2018.

Judging the competition is award-winning artist and gallery owner, **Gordon Haas** from Lambertville, New Jersey. The work in his gallery is full of life, with an ongoing conversation between Italy and the Delaware River echoing from the walls. "You can tell in the final work that I truly enjoy painting and that I never see it as a struggle," Haas says. "The pieces always have a life of their own."
