Steve Kuzma, artist, illustrator and educator has had more than 30 years of professional experience. His clients have included the Olympics, World Cup Soccer, the New York Times, Time Magazine, ABC, CBS and NBC.



Known for his contemporary style and impressionist brushwork, Kuzma uses avant-garde layering techniques in watercolors, water-mixable oils and pastels, offering a blissful connection to nature and spirituality. He makes use of powerful, humanistic and joyous statements with a chiaroscuro of color more than of shadow. Kuzma's love of nature, along with his spiritual awareness, is conveyed in his work. His style blends a strong sense of color and a mastery of layering techniques to provide depth and dimension to his paintings.

Steve Kuzma studied at the Philadelphia College of Art and Parsons New School of Design in New York City. He graduated with honors from Parsons and was awarded fellowships to study overseas in Sienna, Italy and Paris, France. He has lived in southern New Jersey for the last 20 years and in New York City for the preceding decade.

Kuzma maintains a studio at the Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University in Atlantic City, New Jersey.
