A wonderful selection of paintings by NJ artist Philip J. Carroll from his Maine and Nova Scotia series of realistic landscapes in Oil and Watercolor. Carroll feels that “I do not choose the subjects I paint I just happen upon them in my endless wandering for inspiration”. He has been painting the New Jersey landscape for over 40 years and in the last several years has been inspired by the vast vistas of Maine and Nova Scotia.

He currently lives and works in Collingswood, New Jersey. Carroll is a 1984 graduate of the Pennsylvania Academy of The Fine Arts in Philadelphia, PA and studied Art History at The University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, PA. Philip Carroll’s career has brought him to both sides of the figurative fence in terms of producing work and organizing exhibitions as a former Executive Director of the Perkins Center for the Arts in Moorestown, New Jersey. He has worked as an illustrator, muralist, and teacher while painting his own body of work.
