Introduction:

AC Grit is a group exhibition highlighting ten South Jersey-based artists known for their use of vibrant colors, gestural mark-making, and texture. Each artist selected for the exhibition is known in the Atlantic City arts community with public-facing work throughout AC including mural arts, graffiti, and street art. Their determination to solidify Atlantic City as a hub for the arts matches the definition of grit: firmness of mind or spirit: unyielding courage in the face of hardship or danger.

Artist Biographies: Robert (Nexus) Ortiz – Atlantic County, NJ

Bob Ortiz is a self-taught graffiti artist from San Jose, California, who is popular for his vibrant, captivating murals. Although Ortiz began creating art at the early age of five, it was not until high school that he was exposed to graffiti style and found his passion for street art. For over 40 years, Ortiz has been creating murals that strengthen communities and redefine graffiti art in a positive, expressive way. Known for being the originator of the "3D wild style" technique, composed of interwoven letters and images, Ortiz has been named a legend throughout the San Jose Bay Area and continues to build his legacy in South Jersey as a muralist.
