Dolores Park Series Statement

The Dolores Park Series focuses on Dolores Park located in San Francisco, California. Walley lived in San Francisco in 2010 and then again in 2014-2016. While living there she found herself spending time at the park, learning about the land's history, activities, areas of the park and stories from locals. Walley uses an in camera multiple exposure technique to merge the various layers of the park into individual images representing the parks current state during the summer of 2015.
