About the Exhibition:

Drew Griffith makes use of color, texture, depth, and geometric elements to connect with the viewer's subconscious. Paintings are created over time, carefully layering colors and wax that are then burned or "set on fire" to build structure and complexity, pushing you to look more closely. The works are a tactile experience that longs to be touched, examined, and discussed because of what lies just beneath the surface.


