Daniel D’Auria was born in New York in 1957, then raised in New Jersey. He currently works as a physician in southern New Jersey, alongside being an award-winning photographer.

D’Auria received his medical degree from Rutgers Medical School. As he continues to work as a physician, Daniel D’Auria’s career in photography cannot be overlooked.

His passion for wildlife and nature can be seen in his body of work. D’Auria finds fulfillment in observing wild animals interacting with their environment and each other, then bringing the interaction home to share with others through his photography. As D’Auria says, “each photograph should tell a story. These are stories of hope, survival, and the splendor of diversity.” He hopes to inspire his viewers to help preserve our natural world.

In 2018, D’Auria was awarded high honors in Nature’s Best Photo competition, where his photograph spent the year in the Smithsonian. He has received awards from another Smithsonian photo competitions, inclusion in Audubon’s top 100 photos, and one of the top 25 photos for the year on Flickr.com. In addition to his photography, Daniel D’Auria has written and published a series of wildlife themed children’s books that are sold in select national parks.
